





1. Identification / recognition



2. Immobilisation / stabilisation / lifting

Immobilising the vehicle

Press the park button "P" and set the parking brake.



Lifting points



Appropriate lifting points

3. Disable direct hazards / safety regulations

Switching off the ignition



Press the "Start-Engine-Stop" button in the centre console without operating the foot brake.



Remove vehicle key, key card and/ or smartphone app so that they are more than 5 m away from the vehicle if possible.

Disconnecting the 12-volt vehicle battery



In footwell on right side of vehicle



 Remove or lift the floor mats and/or carpet.



Lift off the battery compartment cover.



3. First disconnect the negative terminal (-) and then the positive terminal (+) of the vehicle electrical system battery.

Disconnecting the 48-volt vehicle battery

In the event of an accident in which the airbag is triggered, the 48-volt vehicle electrical system is automatically deactivated as soon as airbag triggering is detected.

For all other cases, the 48-volt vehicle electrical system can be deactivated as follows:





- 1. Remove luggage compartment floor in luggage compartment
- 2. Remove spare wheel or vehicle toolkit (depending on variant)
- 3. Remove the 48 V lithium-ion battery cover by removing the 4 pins with a screwdriver
- 4. Disconnect the communication connector
- 5. Remove the terminal cap
- 6. Release threaded connection of negative terminal (brown/purple cable)




